REDUCTION OF GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS

In Review

- Green Building Ordinance
 - In 2019 the GIAB recommended to Commission a requirement for all new development 5,000+sf to obtain LEED Certification of minimum Gold Level or equivalent
 - Ordinance No. 30-22 adopted November 1, 2022 (effective November 1, 2023)
 - Minimum Level Certification for 15,000 to 50,000 sq ft buildings
 - Silver Level or equivalent certification for 50,000+ sq ft buildings
- Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reduction Planning presented to Commission by OSAR on September 18th

- 50% emission reduction by 2030
- Greenhouse Gas Reduction Program focusing on transportation and buildings
