1978 Purchased our first home on SE 1st Ave

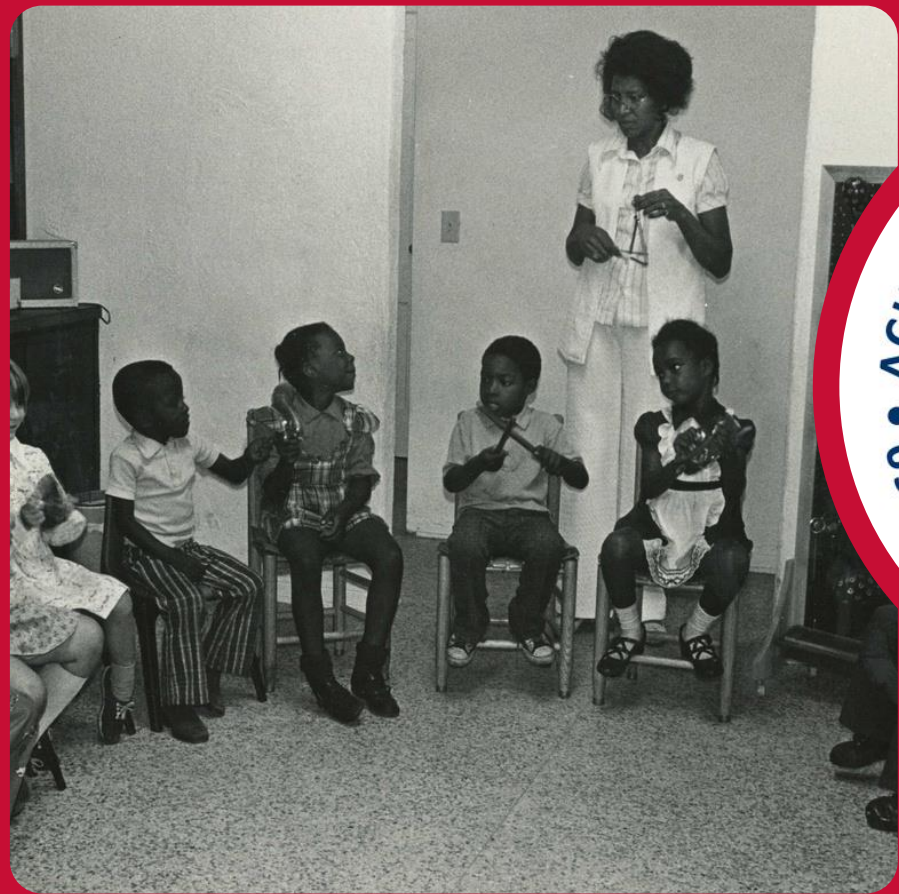
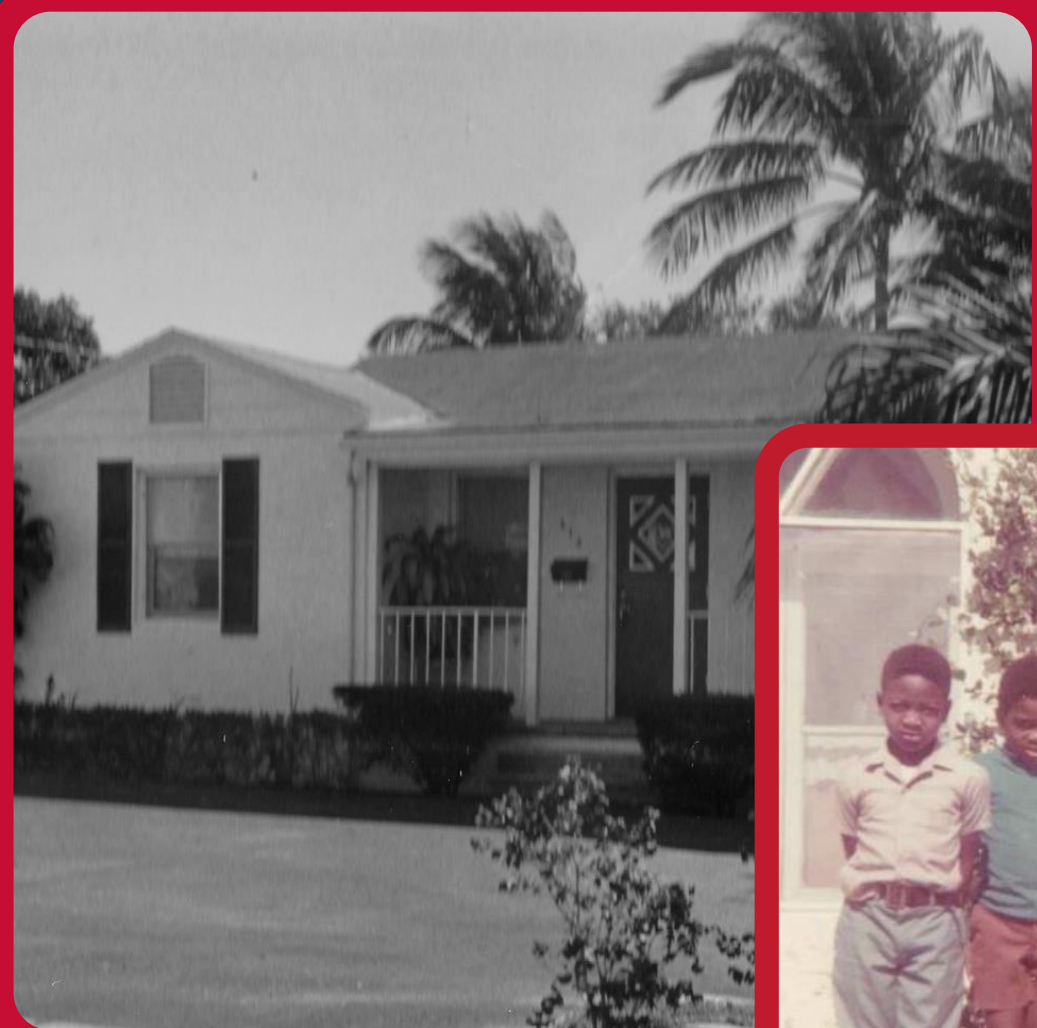
1994 Preschool opens on land donated by the City of Delray Beach

- Cooperative agreement with PBCSD for an on-site Special Needs Resource Teacher

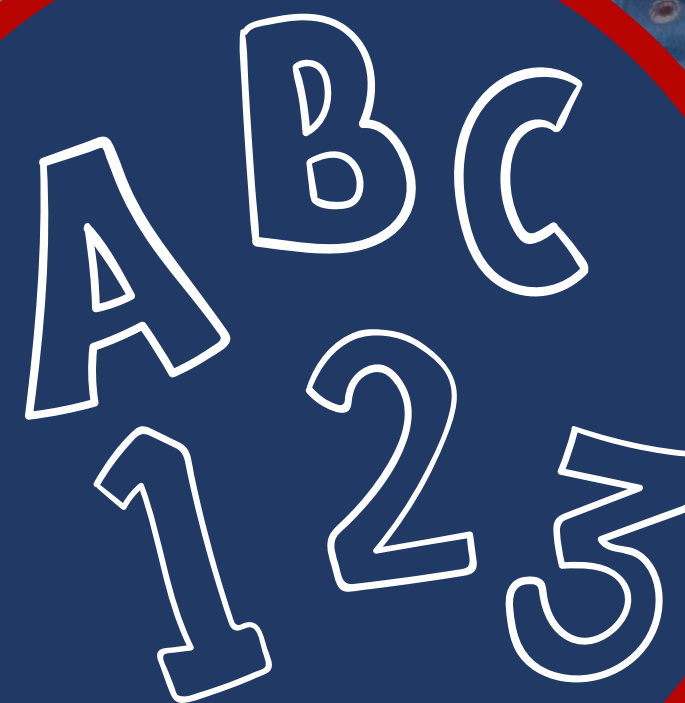

Helping Families Overcome Obstacles in Our Community

- Working families across the country pay a significant percentage of their annual earnings to cover the price of childcare.
- The cost of living in Delray Beach is significantly higher than the national average and is ranked 7 out of 125 for the most expensive cities in Florida.
- 96% of ACCF families fall below the Federal Poverty Level
- Many of ACCF's families cannot afford to live in this community.
