Chair Mazzeo agreed and stated the committee should have the answers to all anticipated questions.

Committee Member Ciancio asked where the presentation is on the agenda. Assistant City Manager Oris stated 4E.

Chair Mazzeo asked if everyone would be present at the Commission meeting on February 3rd. There was an acknowledgement that everyone would be present.

Discussion ensued on how other cities are utilizing the funds.

Chair Mazzeo advised the Fire Department will be installing the first of the Narcan boxes on Wednesday, February 4, 2026 at 1:00 pm at Big Al's on Atlantic Ave.

Discussion ensued on the process that led to Big Al's becoming the first location to have the Narcan box.

Assistant City Manager Oris provided background information on the Narcan box program.
