## **RESOLUTION NO. 168-22**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING A PORTION OF LIVE OAK BOULEVARD, A PRIVATE RIGHT-OF-WAY BETWEEN SOUTH MILITARY TRAIL AND THE INTERSECTION OF WHITE CEDAR LANE IDENTIFIED BY PARCEL CONTROL NUMBER 12424625020000020, AS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A," TO DELAIRE BOULEVARD; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach, Florida ("the City") received an application to designate as Delaire Boulevard a portion of private right-of-way owned by Delaire Country Club Property Owners' Association, Inc., ("Owner") currently known as Live Oak Boulevard, which spans from South Military Trail to White Cedar Lane, as described in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, Owners seek to designate Live Oak Boulevard as Delaire Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, there are no addresses which utilize Live Oak Boulevard; therefore, designating Live Oak Boulevard as Delaire Boulevard will not result in the need to change any property addresses; and

WHEREAS, the City Code of Ordinances ("Code") Section 102.25 states, it shall be the duty of the City Planning and Zoning Board to recommend the designation of names and numbers for streets and it shall be the duty of the Commission of the City to finally determine the designation of names and numbers for streets; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Code Section 102.25, the Planning and Zoning Board formally reviewed the request at a public hearing on October 17, 2022, and voted \_ to \_ to recommend redesignating Live Oak Boulevard to Delaire Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Delray Beach, Florida, deems it to be in the best interest of the City to designate Live Oak Boulevard, which spans from South Military Trail to White Cedar Lane, as ilocated in Exhibit "A", to Delaire Boulevard.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:
