Recommended Action:

Motion to approve the appointment for two (2) regular members to serve a term ending July 31, 2027.

Background:

The term for Mr. Bob Costello and Ms. Sarah Huang will expire on July 31, 2025.

Mr. Bob Costello will have served one (1) full term, is eligible, but would not like to be nominated for reappointment.

Ms. Sarah Huang will have served one (1) full term, is eligible, but would not like to be nominated for reappointment.

The Land Development Regulations Article 8.5 enacted the Public Art Advisory Board for the purpose of advising and making recommendations to the City Commission with respect to public art policy and related issues including, but not limited to, the selection, construction, and placement of public art in/on City right-of-way and City owned property.

The Public Art Advisory Board shall consist of seven (7) members. Three (3) seats on the Board must be filled with either an artist, architect, landscape architect or engineer. Laypersons of knowledge, experience and judgment who have an interest in public art shall make up the balance of the Board.
