

RESOLUTION NO. 50-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH CDW GOVERNMENT, LLC, FOR THE PURCHASE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SOLUTIONS, PRODUCTS, AND SERVICES, UTILIZING CITY OF MESA, ARIZONA, REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS 2024-056; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND/OR RENEWALS THERETO AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (the “City”) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming, and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City requires information technology solutions, products, and services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesa, in partnership with Omnia Partners’ Cooperative Purchasing Program, issued Request for Proposals 2024-056 (the “RFP”) to obtain information technology solutions, products, and services; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the RFP, the City of Mesa entered into an agreement with CDW Government, LLC (“Contactor”); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to obtain aforementioned products and services by utilizing an existing agreement with Contractor pursuant to the RFP; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 46 of the City’s Purchasing Policies and Procedures Manual, the City shall have the authority to join with other units of government in cooperative purchasing plans when the best interests of the City would be served thereby, subject to purchasing authorization levels; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this Agreement between the City and Contractor, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution as “Exhibit A”.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute the Agreement and any amendments and/or renewals thereto, and take any other actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
