

RESOLUTION NO. 170-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF A PURCHASE ORDER TO CENTERLINE SERVICES GROUP, INC., FOR HOME REHABILITATION CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM PURSUANT TO QUICK QUOTE NO. 2025-010; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (“City”) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming, and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City requires home rehabilitation construction services for its Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to issue a purchase order to Centerline Services Group, Inc. (“Contractor”), to obtain these services pursuant to City solicitation Quick Quote Q2025-010; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach hereby approves the issuance of a purchase order to Contractor pursuant to the terms and conditions of Q2025-010, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “A”, and the Contractor’s response thereto, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “B”.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
