Fence replacement is complete.

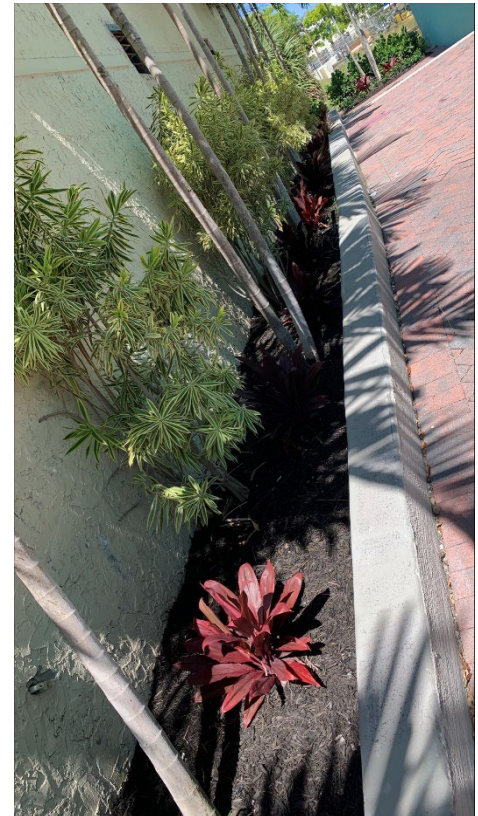
805 West Atlantic Avenue –
