WHEREAS, while there is no known cause of Autism, early diagnosis often makes it possible for individuals to receive resources that can lead to significantly improved lives; and

WHEREAS, Delray Beach is honored to take part in the annual observance of Autism Acceptance Month in the hope that a better informed public will be more inclusive of autistic individuals; and

WHEREAS, to raise awareness Delray Beach will light up City Hall in blue throughout the month of April to educate and increase acceptance and awareness to the general public; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Thomas F. Carney, Jr., Mayor of the City of Delray Beach, Florida, on behalf of the City Commission, do hereby proclaim April as:

“Autism Acceptance Month”
