A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH SULLIVAN ELECTRIC & PUMP, INC., FOR IRRIGATION PUMP STATIONS AND REPAIR SERVICES UTILIZING PALM BEACH COUNTY INVITATION FOR BID NUMBER 23-017/MB; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (the "City") is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming, and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County issued Invitation for Bid ("IFB") No. 23-017/MB to obtain irrigation pump stations and repair services; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with IFB No. 23-017/MB, Palm Beach County entered into an agreement with Sullivan Electric & Pump,Inc. (the "Contractor"); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with the Contractor utilizing Palm Beach County IFB No. 23-017/MB (the "Agreements"); and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves the Agreement between the City and the Contractor, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A".

<u>Section 3.</u> The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and take any action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

<u>Section 4.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
