Traffic Performance Standards (TPS) Review**

Dear Ms. Orr:

The Palm Beach County Traffic Division has reviewed the above referenced project Traffic Impact Statement, revised August 14, 2023, pursuant to the Traffic Performance Standards in Article 12 of the Palm Beach County (PBC) Unified Land Development Code (ULDC). The project is summarized as follows:

Municipality:	Delray Beach
Location:	North of Atlantic Avenue, about 0.23 miles west of Military Trail
PCN:	00-42-46-14-00-000-5190
Access:	Access connection onto Atlantic Avenue via an existing easement <u>(As used in the study and is NOT necessarily an approval by the County through this TPS letter)</u>
Existing Uses:	Vacant
Proposed Uses:	Multi-Family Residential = 116 DUs
New Daily Trips:	782
New Peak Hour Trips:	46 (11/35) AM; 59 (37/22) PM
Build-out:	December 31, 2024

Based on our review, the Traffic Division has determined the proposed development does not have significant peak hour traffic impact (as defined in PBC TPS) on the roadway network and, therefore, **meets** the TPS of Palm Beach County.

Please note the receipt of a TPS approval letter does not constitute the review and issuance of a Palm Beach County Right-of-Way (R/W) Construction Permit nor does it eliminate any requirements that may be deemed as site related. For work within Palm Beach County R/W, a detailed review of the project will be provided upon submittal for a R/W permit application. The project is required to comply with all Palm Beach County standards and may include R/W dedication.

No building permits are to be issued by the City after the build-out date specified above. The County traffic concurrency approval is subject to the Project Aggregation Rules set forth in the Traffic Performance Standards Ordinance.

The approval letter shall be valid no longer than one year from date of issuance, unless an application for a Site Specific Development Order has been approved, an

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application for a Site Specific Development Order has been submitted, or the approval letter has been superseded by another approval letter for the same property.
