**Lucika Suarez, 115 SW 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, stated that Florida Department of Education changed their standards which influenced student performance data due to a lack of baseline data. She also stated that parents and students would benefit from incentives to generate more parental involvement.

**8. NEW BUSINESS****FY'24 Delray Beach Education Data**

**Janai** introduced the FY'24 Delray Beach Education Data which includes socioeconomic status of students residing within the City of Delray Beach, student geographic data, public school grade ratings, student enrollment data, Delray Full-Service Center enrollment data, SY'22-23 Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) assessment data, End of Course (EOC) assessment data, Kindergarten Readiness data, high school graduation rates, and attendance and discipline data. **Janai** explained that each data set was broken into subgroups. **Janai** also explained that the attendance and discipline data included students with chronic absences and both out of school and in school suspensions.

**QUESTIONS/ COMMENTS / DISCUSSION**

**Board** discussion ensued regarding each data set, its implications and impact.

**Kendra** asked how free and reduced lunch data was calculated. **Janai** clarified that the School District of Palm Beach County utilizes the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) to calculate eligible students.

**Joan** asked what initiatives can be implemented to help schools increase parental engagement and visibility. **Anneze** stated that the School District of Palm Beach County offers services and resources for parents and students relating to different topics. **Raiko** questioned whether the parent events are scheduled during working hours and how they can become more accessible (i.e. virtual) for working parents and students.

**Marjorie** questioned the calculation of student percentages and whether the graduation rates included certificates of completion.

**Raiko** questioned comparative discipline data for each subgroup and its calculation.

**Board** discussion ensued regarding attendance and discipline systems and whether discipline policies are aligned with the School District of Palm Beach County's discipline matrix.

**Board** discussed analyzing the data further to determine areas of focus for annual strategic planning.

**Motion** made by **Marjorie Waldo** to compile five-year trend data for 3<sup>rd</sup> grade ELA and Math, 8<sup>th</sup> grade ELA and Math, and 10<sup>th</sup> grade ELA and Algebra EOC, seconded by **Kae Jonsons**. All in favor, none opposed- **motion passed unanimously**.

**Motion** made by **Marjorie Waldo** to have item tabled to a future meeting agenda, seconded by **Kae Jonsons**. All in favor, none opposed- **motion passed unanimously**.

**Raiko** stated she attended School Board member Edwin Ferguson's town hall meeting held at Delray Full-Service Center. She indicated that a program model was discussed that would provide programming similar to Atlantic Technical College.

**Kae** asked if Rob Evans, Economic Development Manager, can attend a meeting to discuss economic and workforce initiatives.

**Board Consensus** was made to have Rob Evans develop a staff report.

**Motion** made by **Marjorie Waldo** to reopen public comments, **seconded by Joan Dorow**. All in favor, none opposed- **motion passed unanimously**.

#### **Staff Comments**

**Janai** provided updates concerning education and workforce initiatives. She stated she is planning a Youth in Government Day in collaboration with the Achievement Center to expose students to local government and systems. She also stated she is working with the Delray Beach Chamber of Commerce to host an Automotive Industry Tour for students

from Atlantic High School, Village Academy, Park Vista High School, and Seminole Ridge High School.
