A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH MOCK ROOS & ASSOCIATES, INC., FOR PROFESSIONAL CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING SERVICES RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THOMAS STREET STORMWATER PUMP STATION IMPROVEMENTS, PURSUANT TO REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS 2023-048; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND/OR RENEWALS THERETO AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City requires professional construction engineering services for the construction of a new stormwater pump and related improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with Mock Roos & Associates, Inc., ("Contractor") for these services pursuant to Request for Qualifications 2023-048 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:
