

RESOLUTION NO. 210-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH LHOIST NORTH AMERICA OF ALABAMA, LLC TO FURNISH, DELIVER, AND DISCHARGE QUICKLIME, UTILIZING THE SE FLORIDA GOVERNMENTAL PURCHASING CO-OP'S SOLICITATION NO 23-36B; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND/OR RENEWALS THERETO AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase quicklime and related services; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to retain Lhoist North America Of Alabama, LLC to furnish, deliver, and discharge quicklime by utilizing the terms and conditions provided to the SE Florida Governmental Purchasing Co-Op, and its lead agency for the purchase, the City of Tamarac, pursuant to Solicitation No. 23-36B; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this Agreement between the City and Lhoist North America Of Alabama, LLC, which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A".

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and/or renewals thereto and take any and all actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
