RESOLUTION NO. 231-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH TEN-8 FIRE & SAFETY LLC, FOR THE PURCHASE OF A PUMPER TRUCK AND A LADDER TRUCK, AS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN, UTILIZING SOURCEWELL RFP NO. 113021; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND/OR RENEWALS THERETO AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell administers a Cooperative Purchasing Program wherein it performs solicitations for a multitude of products and administers the resulting contracts; and

WHEREAS, contracts solicited by Sourcewell are accessible to federal, state/province, and municipal government entities, higher education, K-12 education, nonprofit, tribal government, and other public entities located in the United States and Canada; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell issued RFP No. 113021 to obtain vendors for firefighting apparatus and fire service vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Ten-8 Fire Safety and Equipment, Inc., is one of the authorized dealers awarded the contract under Sourcewell Contract No. 113021-OKC; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to obtain these products and services by utilizing the terms and conditions of an existing agreement with Ten-8 Fire Safety and Equipment, Inc., pursuant to Sourcewell Contract No. 113021-OKC for the purchase of one (1) new Pierce Enforcer Pumper Truck and one (1) new Pierce Enforcer Ladder Truck; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this Agreement between the City and Contractor, which is attached to this Resolution as "Exhibit A".

<u>Section 3</u>. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and/or renewals and take any and all actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

<u>Section 4.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
