CRA Managed Properties
700 West Atlantic Avenue –

Preparation for demolition has commenced. Notices have been sent to all current tenants.

Commercial Backflow installed for future development. SWA Grant received for demolition has been extended to April 30, 2024.

23 NW 7th Avenue –

Preparation for demolition of unused parking lot will begin in February 2024.

36 SW 6th Avenue –

TUA for City Contractor to use the property for parking and staging as it relates to the City Sidewalk/ ADA Improvement Project extended until July 2024

46 and 48 SW 6th Avenue –

TUA for CRA Contractor to use the properties for parking and staging as it relates to the 95 SW 5th Avenue development project.

805 West Atlantic Avenue –

Additional testing and monitoring is ongoing – as needed by the State of Florida and Palm Beach County to complete remediation of the site.

135 NW 5th Avenue –

Roof replacement permit approved and work will be scheduled for January 2024.

Rev. Dr. JWH. Thomas Park –

Gate has been installed along with park hours signs.

Other –

Holiday lighting and décor was been installed on developed CRA-owned properties in December 2023 and will be removed in January 2024.

Ongoing maintenance, pressure washing, and trash pickup continue for CRA- owned and managed properties.

No Trespassing, No Loitering, and No Illegal Dumping Signs are being placed on all CRA Properties and all trespass affidavits with the City of Delray Beach for all properties are up to date.

Future tree planting is being planned for various CRA-owned properties in collaboration with the City of Delray Beach and Community Greening.
