

# CERTIFICATE OF RECOGNITION FOR TEMPLE SINAI

The City of Delray Beach proudly recognizes Temple Sinai for its commitment to serving the community.

Temple Sinai volunteers provide food, water, clothing, and toiletries, all funded by their volunteers for those in need in our community. Temple Sinai is committed to serving our neighbors in many other meaningful ways. Their Social Action Committee collected more than 40 pairs of shoes for children and teens for a charity called In Jacob's Shoes. They collect many pounds of food for the Jacobson Food Pantry during the High Holy Days and throughout the year and have provided ongoing financial support to both the Jacobson Food Pantry and C.R.O.S. Ministries for many years. Every eight weeks, they host OneBlood's Big Red Bus in their parking lot for community blood drives.

Their commitment to the community extends beyond charitable giving. They partner with Scout Troop 308 by providing space for functions throughout the year and are proud members of the Delray Beach Chamber of Commerce. Temple Sinai also provides meeting space for AI-Anon and other community support groups, helping to foster connection and support for those in need.

They actively build relationships with other faith-based communities to promote mutual understanding and cooperation through interfaith programs and events. In partnership with St. Paul's Episcopal Church, they host an annual interfaith Thanksgiving service and are the founding house of worship for the Anti-Bias Coalition of Delray Beach. Through their religious, educational, and cultural programming, they strive to create opportunities that are welcoming and inclusive to all members of the community.

Temple Sinai's commitment to the broader community is also reflected in the leadership and service of their clergy. Rabbi Moss is on the Delray Beach Police Advisory Board, Co-Chair of the Anti-Bias Coalition of Delray Beach, Chaplain to the Delray Beach Police Department and the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office, Founder and Senior Chaplain to the Emergency Chaplains' Group for the Delray Beach Medical Center, a Board Member on the Delray Beach Interfaith Committee for Social Services, a member of the Palm Beach County Attorney's Office Hate Crimes Task Force, President of the Palm Beach County Board of Rabbis, and attends the monthly meetings of the Delray Beach Initiative to End Homelessness.
