

RESOLUTION NO. 75-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH AUSTIN TUPLER TRUCKING, INC. AND RANGER CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRIES, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF ASPHALT AND NON-ASPHALT ROAD CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS PURSUANT TO INVITATION TO BID 2026-018; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND/OR RENEWALS THERETO AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (“City”) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming, and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase asphalt and non-asphalt road construction materials; and

WHEREAS, the City is a member of the Southeast Florida Governmental Purchasing Cooperative, a Cooperative formed in an effort to provide cost savings and cost avoidances to all entities by utilizing the buying power of combined requirements for common, basic items for its approximately 45 government entity members; and

WHEREAS, the City, operating as the lead agency for the benefit of the City and the Members of the Southeast Florida Governmental Purchasing Cooperative Group, issued Solicitation ITB2026-018 (the “Solicitation”) for purchase of asphalt and non-asphalt road construction materials; and

WHEREAS, on March 3, 2026, the City received two (2) responses to the Solicitation and desires to enter into agreements with two of the proposers: Austin Tupler Trucking, Inc. and Ranger Construction Industries, Inc., (collectively the “Contractors”), for the purchase of asphalt and non-asphalt road construction materials pursuant to Invitation to Bid No. 2026-018; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves the agreements between the City and the Contractors, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Composite Exhibit “A”.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and/or renewals and take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
