

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Mr. Martinek, as per emails & conversation with Clinton Williams for road closure on this project the reason for road closures is due to 80% of poles being install on this project will be 8 kip concrete which require a large crane to extends the outriggers for stability to set the concrete poles. See screen shot below as an example of one of the poles on the Southeast corner of NE 1st St & NE 5th Ave. The project weather permitting will take about 3 months to completed & the road closure will only occur for the duration of installing the pole which should take 3 to 4 hours. Once the pole is setup crews will only need the single lane next to pole to install new hardware & transfer lines. Work on the alleys will require the alley to be close for the duration of work hours to setup equipment to set the poles. Due to the volume of traffic & pedestrian in the area I propose to Clinton that Pike crews would be working only Monday night to Thursday night from 9pm to 5am. The only documentation I have is the documents I provided to Clinton Williams which were the COI & MOT print. Pike will provide police officers to assist in traffic flow & prevent issues.
