

WHEREAS, recognition should be given to the value of trees in our community and the need for a continual city-wide forestry program for the benefit of all persons; and

WHEREAS, the holiday to recognize the importance of trees in our lives, was proclaimed at the federal level in 1970, by President Richard Nixon and is celebrated the last Friday in April as National Arbor Day; and

WHEREAS, the National Arbor Day Foundation, in cooperation with the U.S. Forest Service and the National Association of State Foresters, sponsor a project known as “Tree City USA” in an effort to make every community in America a better place in which to live; and

WHEREAS, the protection and proliferation of trees within the City of Delray Beach is governed by regulations for the purpose of promoting the health, safety, welfare, and aesthetic quality of the community by realizing the importance of trees for oxygen production, carbon dioxide absorption, dust and air pollution filtration, wind and noise reduction, soil erosion prevention, surface drainage improvement, energy conservation, beautification and aesthetic enhancement of all lands in the City; and

WHEREAS, the optimum time of the year for planting most species of trees in Southeastern Florida is in the springtime due to the mild temperatures and the beginning of the wet season; and

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach will celebrate Arbor Day with a tree giveaway on April 20, 2024, and a Tree Planting Program virtual presentation posting on April 26, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, THOMAS F. CARNEY, JR., Mayor of the City of Delray Beach, Florida, on behalf of the City Commission, do hereby proclaim April 26, 2024, as:

ARBOR DAY

in the City of Delray Beach, Florida, and urge all citizens, schools, businesses, and community organizations to join with me in recognizing the value and the need for trees within our community.
