## QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES:

**Q1. When will the new Payroll application implementation begin? When does the City expect to be live with the new Payroll system?**

R1. At this time, the City does not have a pre-determined start date for the new payroll application. However it is anticipated to be in the first half of FY 2017.

**Q2. Does the City currently utilize an IVR (Interactive Voice Response) system for another purpose? If so, what vendor solution is being utilized?**

R2. Yes, the City utilizes an IVR system. Beginning in July 2016 Maxis360 (VoIP) will develop the required IVR functionality.

**Q3. Will the City consider vendors that provide biometric clocks with one-verification?**

R3. Yes, the City will consider biometric blocks with one-verification method.

**Q4. How many users will need proximity support?**

R4. The City estimates that 579 users will need proximity support. A breakdown by department/division is listed below.
