**WHEREAS**, on Florida's busy roadways, pedestrians are urged to always remain alert and make proper use of pedestrian crossings; and

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Highway Patrol (FHP), and public safety partners across the state are joining forces to remind drivers and pedestrians that staying safe on Florida's roadways is a shared responsibility.
