## **RESOLUTION NO. 48-25**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH EMS TECHNOLOGY SOLUTIONS, LLC FOR INVENTORY AND ASSET MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AS A CITY STANDARD; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND/OR RENEWALS THERETO AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (the "City") is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming, and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City requires inventory and asset management software for its Fire Rescue Department; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an Agreement with EMS Technology Solutions, LLC ("EMS Technology"), finding that the software and services offered by EMS Technology are a City Standard as detailed in the Memorandum for City Standard Approval dated January 31, 2025, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

<u>Section 2.</u> The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach confirms this purchase as a City Standard purchase, as defined in the City's Purchasing and Procedures Manual, and hereby approves the Agreement between the City and EMS Technology Solutions, LLC, which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "B".

<u>Section 3.</u> The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and/or renewals and take any and all actions necessary to effectuate this Resolution.
