

RESOLUTION NO. 12-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH SSES, INC., DBA SOUTHERN SEWER EQUIPMENT SALES, AS AN APPROVED SOLE SOURCE, TO PURCHASE VAC-CON ORIGINAL EQUIPMENT MANUFACTURER PARTS AND SERVICES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (the “City”) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming, and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to procure Vac-Con Original Equipment Manufacturer (“OEM”) parts and services for the purpose of maintaining and servicing City-owned street sweepers and vacuum trucks; and

WHEREAS, Vac-Con OEM parts and services are provided exclusively through Contractor to be sold in the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2025, in accordance with Section 38 of the City’s Purchasing Policies and Procedures Manual, the Contractor was approved as a Sole Source pursuant to the Memorandum attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “A”; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with the Contractor, as a Sole Source, to obtain the aforementioned goods and services (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves the Agreement between the City and Contractor, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “B”.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments thereto and take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
