ECONOMIC PROSPERITY ELEMENT

WHAT IS THE ECONOMIC PROSPERITY ELEMENT?

The Economic Prosperity Element is new to the City's Comprehensive Plan and provides context for policy, resource allocation and guidance as to how the City will seek to ensure prosperity as the city's economy develops and evolves.

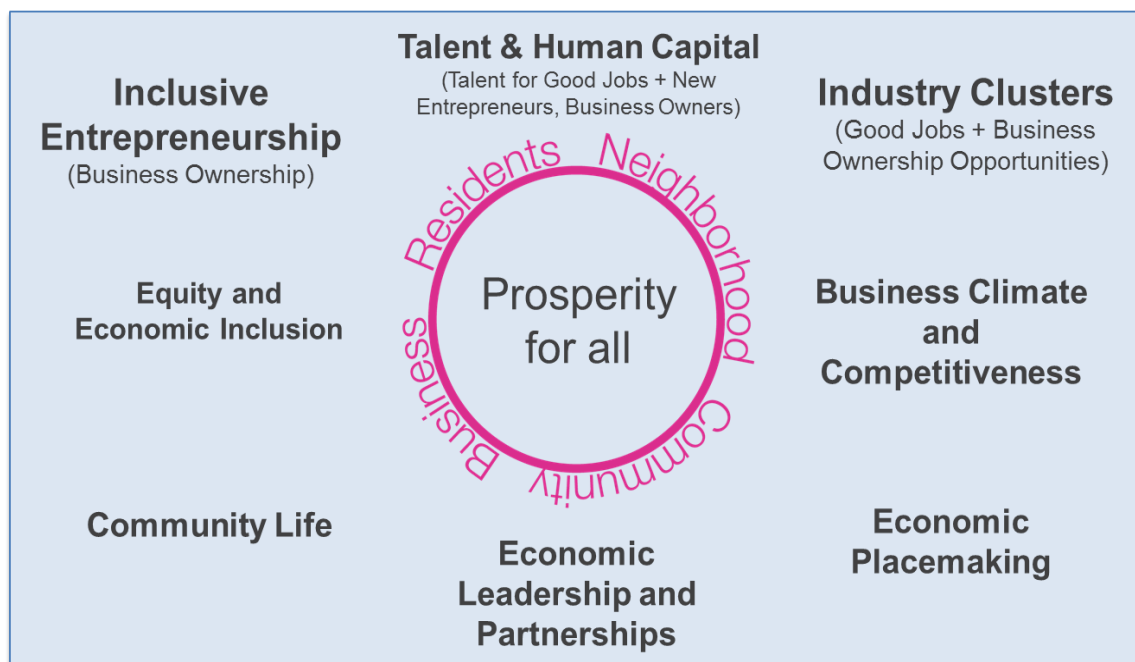
The International Economic Development Council defines economic development as "a process that influences growth and restructuring of an economy to enhance the economic well-being of a community." Community benefits from a success economic development approach and strategy including: 1) new business activity; 2) higher incomes; 3) wealth-building; and 4) tax revenues to fund public services and community life investments.

Effective economic development involves a coordinated cross-disciplinary approach to business attraction, business development, business retention, workforce capacity-building, tourism, and infrastructure investments, as drivers of economic growth.

The City has focused on growing local businesses, business retention and expansion, redevelopment and revitalization, downtown development, tourism and sports, arts and culture, special events, and community development as economic development strategies. While this approach has been effective, investments in people, place, and industry development are necessary to fill gaps in the City industries and economic outcomes.

Additionally, Delray Beach's prior economic success does not yet mean prosperity for all. The market forces that accompany an economic boom and population growth have exacerbated the issue of affordability for many residents and businesses in Delray Beach. Questions of equity - who and how many benefit from Delray Beach's prosperity - have resounded through the city and our community for years and must be addressed if there will be prosperity for all: residents, neighborhoods, businesses and the community overall.

These goals, objectives, and policies provide the guidance for this evolving economic approach.

Expand Inc. Pad, a small business resource center situated on the 2nd floor of the Library. [Complete by 20XX]

Policy ECP 2.1.2

Collaborate with organizations to bring more entrepreneurial programming and services to Delray Beach particularly for youth entrepreneurs and entrepreneurs of color. [Ongoing]

Policy ECP 2.1.3

Coordinate with organizations that provide microloans, small business loans and other financial resources to fund new businesses and business expansions and encourage entrepreneurs to explore innovative financing strategies. [Ongoing]



Objective ECP 2.2 Small Business Support

Obtain regular feedback from area small businesses and entrepreneurial firms.

Continue annual business walks in commercial corridors and business neighborhoods to collect data and information. [Ongoing]

Conduct an annual small business survey to gauge business confidence and state of business competitiveness. [Annually]

Continue the G.E.A.R. (Grow, Expand, Attact and Retain) Team and program with economic development partners to monitor and save “at-risk” businesses, attract new firms and share business intelligence. [Ongoing]

Improve access to contracting, projects or the procurement of goods and services for minority-owned, woman-owned and emerging small businesses.

Policy ECP 4.1.1

Support organizations and business partners which assist in growing the local economic capacity. [Ongoing]

Policy ECP 4.1.2

Create a database of available land and buildings available within the City appropriate for industry clusters. [Create by 20XX]



Objective ECP 4.2 Business Support Services

Ensure the availability of business support services in Delray Beach city limits.

Policy ECP 4.2.1

Maintain a forum for businesses to provide feedback to the City about local business needs. [Ongoing]

Policy ECP 4.2.2

Create a unified marketing message about business assistance services available to businesses and industries with easy to navigate linkages across programs and agencies. [Create by 20XX]

Expand City programs to support businesses at risk of relocating *outside of Delray Beach* due to rising rent costs. [Complete by 20XX]

Maintain a website that provides information on all business and industry assistance in one central location. [Ongoing]
