Contextual Appropriateness

The integration of Art Deco / Moderne elements resonates with the community's aesthetic and enhances the overall streetscape, creating a visually appealing and contextually appropriate structure.

Design Elements

- Flat Roof with Concealing Parapets: The flat roof design, complemented by parapets that
 conceal mechanical systems, maintains the clean lines typical of Art Deco architecture while
 promoting a polished silhouette against the sky.
- 2. **Rounded Corners and Windows**: The incorporation of rounded corners and windows softens the building's mass and provides an inviting, approachable facade. This detail not only echoes traditional Art Deco forms but also enhances pedestrian experience.
- 3. **Horizontal Lines and Banding**: Horizontal stucco banding and railings emphasize the building's linearity, echoing the streamlined aesthetics of Art Deco. This design detail aids in breaking up vertical expanses and contributes to a grounded appearance.

- 4. **Vertically Oriented Marquee Element & Flagpole**: A vertically oriented marquee element serves as a focal point and provides a visual anchor.
- 5. **Cantilevered Eyebrows**: The cantilevered eyebrows over the windows offer shade and protection while adding depth to the facade. This feature not only serves a practical purpose but also enhances the Art Deco character through its sculptural form.
- 6. **Light, Neutral, Smooth Stucco Exterior**: The choice of a light, neutral smooth stucco finish promotes a clean and modern nautical look that harmonizes with the coastal environment of Delray Beach. This finish is both timeless and versatile, allowing for seasonal updates through landscaping and decor.
- 7. **Recessed Entry and Balconies**: The recessed front entry door provides a sense of arrival and transition, while the balconies promote interaction with the surrounding neighborhood, supporting the community-centric ethos of Delray Beach.
- 8. **Geometric Stucco Reliefs**: The use of geometric reliefs on the building facade adds textural variety and captures the essence of Art Deco design. These reliefs draw the eye and contribute to the building's overall richness.
- Metal Doors with Large Glass Openings: The incorporation of metal doors featuring
 expansive glass openings ensures ample natural light, fostering an inviting atmosphere while
 maintaining transparency between indoor and outdoor environments.
