

RESOLUTION NO. 44-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH FLORIDATOURS.COM FOR CHARTER BUS SERVICES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND/OR RENEWALS THERETO AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City requires Charter Bus services for its Parks and Recreation Department; and

WHEREAS, the City issued Request for Proposal 2023-003 to procure said services and received one responsive proposal; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's Purchasing Policies and Procedures, the Selection Committee determined that FloridaTours.com was responsible and the submittal was responsive; and

WHEREAS, the Selection Committee agreed to move forward with FloridaTours.Com for said services in accordance with the City's Request for Proposal 2023-003; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this Agreement between the City and FloridaTours.com, which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A".

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and/or renewals thereto and take any other actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
