PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Parental Alienation Awareness Day (PAAD) is part of a global awareness campaign to raise awareness about parental alienation to educate caregivers, families, and the public about the signs of parental alienation and its potential harm to children; and

WHEREAS, parental alienation occurs when one parent intentionally undermines a child's relationship with the other parent, often through denigration or manipulation; and

WHEREAS, behaviors such as speaking negatively to a parent to, or in front of, a child can destroy the bond between a loving parent and child; and

WHEREAS, parental alienation deprives children of the right to love and be loved by their whole family, resulting in a psychological impact on children, and as such, it is considered a form of child abuse; and

WHEREAS, The Toby Center provides education and resources to a worldwide community of parents and children who are affected by parental alienation, and promotes public awareness.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, THOMAS F. CARNEY, JR., Mayor of the City of Delray Beach, Florida, on behalf of the City Commissioners, hereby supports Parental Alienation Day and proclaims April 25, 2025, as
