

RESOLUTION NO. 167-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT THE INTERSECTION OF W LINTON BOULEVARD AND CATHERINE DRIVE/LINTON LAKES DRIVE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (“City”) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City approved a traffic light improvements project (Project#2020-001) (“Project”) at the intersection of W. Linton Boulevard and Catherine Drive (“Location”) to improve the intersection and safety of the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Project a traffic light will be installed at the Location, which includes City and Palm Beach County (“County”) right-of-way and privately owned land; and

WHEREAS, the County require a formal agreement for the installation of the traffic light; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves the Interlocal Agreement Between Palm Beach County and the City of Delray Beach for the Design and Construction of a Traffic Signal at the Intersection of W Linton Boulevard and Catherine Drive/Linton Lakes Drive, which is attached as Exhibit “A”.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and/or renewals thereto and take any other actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
