

RESOLUTION NO. 91-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH GENUINE PARTS COMPANY DBA NAPA AUTO PARTS FOR AFTERMARKET VEHICLE PARTS AND SUPPLIES UTILIZING SOURCEWELL CONTRACT NO. 100124-GPC; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach ("City") is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City requires aftermarket vehicle parts and supplies; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell administers a Cooperative Purchasing Program wherein it performs solicitations for a multitude of products and administers the resulting contracts; and

WHEREAS, contracts solicited by Sourcewell are accessible to state government entities and other public entities located in the United States and Canada; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell issued Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 100124 to obtain aftermarket vehicle parts and supplies; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with RFP No. 100124, Sourcewell entered into Contract No. 100124-GPC with Genuine Parts Company dba NAPA Auto Parts ("Contractor"); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to obtain aftermarket vehicle parts and supplies by utilizing the existing Contract No. 100124-GPC with Contractor, pursuant to Sourcewell, RFP No. 100124; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 25 of the City's Purchasing Policies and Procedures Manual, Piggybacking on State, County, other municipalities, and other government entity bids is permitted within the approval thresholds of the City Manager or City Commission, as applicable in accordance with the purchasing criteria set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with Contractor, as a Piggyback ("Agreement"), to obtain aftermarket vehicle parts and supplies; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves the Agreement between the City and Contractor, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “A”.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
