## **RESOLUTION NO. 243-23**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN IMPACT EVENT KNOWN AS THE 3RD ANNUAL DELRAY BEACH CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE 2024 TO BE SET-UP ON APRIL 20, 2024 AND HELD APRIL 21, 2024 IN AND AROUND THE OLD SCHOOL SQUARE CAMPUS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Delray Beach recognizes the importance of special events and the opportunities they provide to promote community welfare, improve the quality of life of residents and visitors, build a sense of community, provide enriched cultural opportunities, draw visitors to the City, and contribute to the local economy; and

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach Special Event Policy defines "impact events" as special events that require City Commission approval as a result of certain characteristics such as their potential to significantly disrupt the regular function of the area of the City in which they will be held, their potential to attract more than 3,500 people, or their need to close one or more major roadways in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach, Florida received a Special Event Application (the "Application") from the Delray Beach Concours Foundation seeking approval for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Delray Beach Concours d'Elegance 2024 (the "Event") to be set up on April 20, 2024 and held April 21, 2024.

WHEREAS, the Event anticipates attendance of 5,000 people on April 21, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Application was reviewed and approved by the City's Special Event Technical Advisory Committee at its meeting of September 28, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has reviewed the number of anticipated attendees at the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Delray Beach Concours d'Elegance and considered the impacts upon the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:
