WHEREAS, residents have the opportunity to experience the pleasure of walking as a source of health and exercise as well as transportation; and

WHEREAS, in 2023, the Florida Department of Transportation statistics show 771 people were killed walking on roads and streets; and

WHEREAS, to address this serious problem, drivers and pedestrians must work together to demonstrate safe behaviors on the road, helping to protect themselves and those around them; and

WHEREAS, on Florida’s busy roadways, pedestrians are urged to always remain alert and make proper use of pedestrian crossings; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Highway Patrol (FHP), and public safety partners across the state are joining forces to remind drivers and pedestrians that staying safe on Florida’s roadways is a shared responsibility.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Thomas F. Carney, Jr., Mayor of the City of Delray Beach, do hereby proclaim October 2025 as:

PEDESTRIAN SAFETY MONTH

in the City of Delray Beach and urge all citizens to exercise pedestrian and motorist safety precautions.
