REINSTATEMENT AND SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE WORK ASSIGNMENT BETWEEN THE DELRAY BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY AND CPZ ARCHITECTS, INC.

THIS REINSTATEMENT AND SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE WORK ASSIGNMENT ("Second Amendment") is made and entered into this _____ day of___, 2022, by and between the DELRAY BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, (hereinafterreferred to as "CRA") and CPZ ACHITECTS, INC., (hereinafter referred to as "CONSULTANT").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the CRA and the CONSULTANT previously entered into an Agreement for General Consulting Service dated October 1, 2018, (the "Original Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the CRA and the CONSULTANT entered into a Work Assignment, on April 1, 2021 ("Work Assignment"), to provide consulting services pursuant to the Original Agreement for the CRA Project, Conceptual Design of New Livable Environment for the 800 Block of Atlantic Avenue Using Shipping Containers ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the CRA and the CONSULTANT entered into a First Amendment to the Work Assignment to revise the Scope of Services for the Project and to extend the Termination Date to December 31, 2021 ("First Amendment").

WHEREAS, the CRA and the CONSULTANT agree to enter into a Second Amendment to the Work Assignment to reinstate the Work Assignment, amend the Scope of Services to provide additional services as described in the Exhibit "A", which Is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, and extend the Termination Date of the Work Assignment to April 30, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises herein contained, the CRA and the CONSULTANT agree as follows:

- 1. That the "WHEREAS" clauses recited above are hereby incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. Effective as the date first written above, the CRA and CONSULTANT hereby agree to reinstate the Work Assignment.
- 3. That the CRA and the CONSULTANT agree to amend the Scope of Services to provide additional services as described in Exhibit "A."
- 4. That the CRA and the CONSULTANT agree to hereby amend the Work Assignment to extend the Termination Date to April 30, 2023.

- 5. That except as amended herein, the CRA and CONSULTANT ratify, approve, and reaffirm the terms of the Original Agreement, the Work Assignment, and the First Amendment and the Original Agreement, Work Assignment and First Amendment shall remain in full force and effect, except as amended herein.
- 6. In the event of any conflict or ambiguity by and between the terms and provisions of the Original Agreement, the Work Assignment, the First Amendment and this Second Amendment, this Second Amendment shall control to the extent of any such conflict or ambiguity.

As requested, we are pleased to offer the following fee proposal to provide Architectural, Engineering Design Services for the above referenced project.

SCOPE

We will provide design services for the continued conceptual design of a new livable environment on the 800 block on West Atlantic Avenue using shipping containers.

1. Conceptual Design

- a. Review environmental site limitations. Before we start working on the final design, we will review County Reports to understand if the SE corner can be used. CRA Staff to provide the County/FDEP reports.
 - Look at opportunities to utilize/activate the SE corner lot for stage, or temporary use (above/on grade), etc. Identify possibilities / limitations based on County/FDEP requirements.
- b. Develop Site Plan Layout
 - i. re-arrange site to keep noise generating components toward Atlantic and away from residential area, buffering use element.
 - ii. We will prepare one final design with (2) two rounds of review with CRA Staff and (1) one review by CRA Board.
