

RESOLUTION NO. 202-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, CONFIRMING A DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY, AND AUTHORIZING THE EVACUATION OF CERTAIN AREAS OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, a State of Emergency in the City of Delray Beach was proclaimed on November 9, 2022 due to Hurricane Nicole; and

WHEREAS, citizens must be moved from harm's way; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 95 of the City of Delray Beach Code of Ordinances authorizes the activation of plans for evacuation during a state of emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A declaration of a State of Emergency proclaimed on November 9, 2022 is hereby confirmed.


Section 2. Hurricane Nicole has seriously affected and threatened the lives and property of residents of the City of Delray Beach and requires the evacuation of citizens from the following area(s):

Zone A (manufactured and mobile housing) and Zone B (which includes the barrier island), consistent the county's mandate. This will take effect upon execution of this Resolution.


Section 3. Such evacuation shall remain in effect until competent authority declares the state of emergency terminated.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect at the date and time specified in Section 2.
