Subject: **State Lobbyist Requests for Delray Beach**

Date: August 31, 2016

1. Modification of Section 509.032 (7)(b) of the Florida Statutes to allow municipalities to regulate Vacation Rental turnovers in Single Family neighborhoods.
2. To have SAMSHA Grants available for cities to purchase Naloxone to meet the opioid overdose crisis needs. (Narcan)
3. To lobby for SAMSHA funds to be earmarked for public detox beds for Palm Beach County and specifically for DAF (only 16 detox beds in this County).
4. To have more State Law Enforcement Investigators assigned to this County for Patient Brokering and Fraudulent Insurance Practices enforcement. (Mr. Attwater's Office.)
5. To support and facilitate the reintroduction of the Marketing Practices Legislation for Addiction Treatment Programs. (Sen. Clemens)
6. To have DCF increase Circuit 15 enforcement personnel to regulate Licensed Recovery Services providers. The industry is corrupting rapidly, and the West Palm Region Office is horribly understaffed and ineffective.
7. Appropriate 100% of Florida Housing's state funds through the Trust Funds created by the Sadowski Act.
