FOR PRINT GOODS AND SERVICES, UTILIZING OMNIA PARTNERS RFP NO. 001811-FEB2020: AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY RENEWALS AND/OR AMENDMENTS THERETO AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Omnia Partners issued Request For Proposal ("RFP") No.001811-FEB2020 to obtain vendors for print goods and services for itself and participating entities; and

WHEREAS, Canon Solutions America, Inc. ("Contractor") was awarded one of the contracts, Contract No.2020002755, pursuant to the solicitation; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to obtain these print goods and services utilizing the terms and conditions of an existing agreement with the University of California, pursuant to Omnia Partners RFP No. 001811-FEB2020; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves Section 2. this Agreement between the City and Contractor utilizing Omnia Partners Contract No. 202000275, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A".
