

RESOLUTION NO. 230-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING A GRANT AGREEMENT (L0179) WITH FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR FUNDING OF THE DELRAY BEACH GULFSTREAM BOULEVARD AND SE 36TH AVENUE STREETScape IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND/OR RENEWALS AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach ("City") is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming, and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the westbound lane of SE 36th Avenue resides in the City of Boynton Beach, and the eastbound lane of SE 36th Avenue resides in the City of Delray Beach, and the median between the lanes is owned and maintained equally by each city; and

WHEREAS, the City previously entered into an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Boynton Beach for the shared expenses of the engineering design for improvements to SE 36th Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the planning and design phase of the Project is complete, and the construction phase shall commence upon execution of a new Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City administers a Capital Improvement Program ("Program"); and

WHEREAS, as part of this Program, the City has allocated funds for the Delray Beach Gulfstream Boulevard and SE 36th Avenue Streetscape Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with Florida Department of Environmental Protection to obtain state grant funding in the amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) to partially fund the City of Delray Beach's cost share for this project; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this Agreement between the City and Florida Department of Environmental Protection, which is attached to this resolution as Exhibit A.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and/or renewals thereto and take any other actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
