

RESOLUTION NO. 05-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING AGREEMENT WITH HENRY SCHEIN INC., FOR SUPPLIES, EQUIPMENT, AND PHARMACETICALS UTILIZING EAGLE COUNTY HEALTH SERVICES DISTRICT DBA EAGLE COUNTY PARAMEDIC SERVICES AND PUBLIC SAFETY ASSOCIATION INC RFB NO. 2024-02; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND/OR RENEWALS THERETO AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (the “City”) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming, and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City requires supplies, equipment, and pharmaceuticals for its Fire Rescue Department; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to obtain these products and services by utilizing an existing agreement with Henry Schein, Inc. (“Supplier”), pursuant to Eagle County Health Service District dba Eagle County Paramedic Services and the Public Safety Association, Inc. request for Bid No. 2024-02; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves the Agreement between the City and the Contractor, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “A”.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and take any action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
