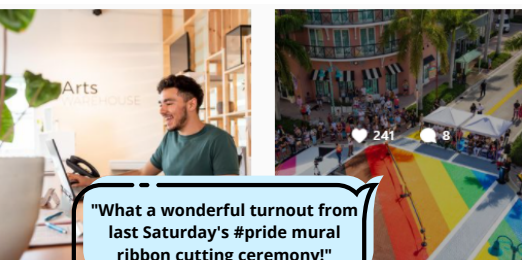
Wellbrock House: Historic Designation Acknowledgment
