

RESOLUTION NO. 188-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH DIGITECH COMPUTER LLC., FOR THE PURCHASE OF THIRD PARTY BILLING SERVICES FOR EMERGENCY TRANSPORT SERVICES, UTILIZING CITY OF FERNANDINA BEACH REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL 24-07; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND/OR RENEWALS THERETO AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (“City”) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming, and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City requires third party billing for emergency transport services for the City; and

WHEREAS, City of Fernandina Beach issued RFP 24-07 to obtain third party billing for emergency transport services; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Request for Proposal 24-07, City of Fernandina Beach entered into an agreement with Digitech Computer LLC. (“Contractor”); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to obtain these aforementioned services by utilizing an existing Agreement with Contractor pursuant to City of Fernandina Beach issued RFP 24-07; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 25 of the City’s Purchasing Policies and Procedures Manual, Piggybacking on State, County, other municipalities, and other government entity bids is permitted within the approval thresholds of the City Manager or City Commission, as applicable in accordance with the purchasing criteria set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with Contractor, as a Piggyback, to obtain third party billing for emergency transport services; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves

this Agreement between the City and Contractor, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “A”.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and take any action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
