



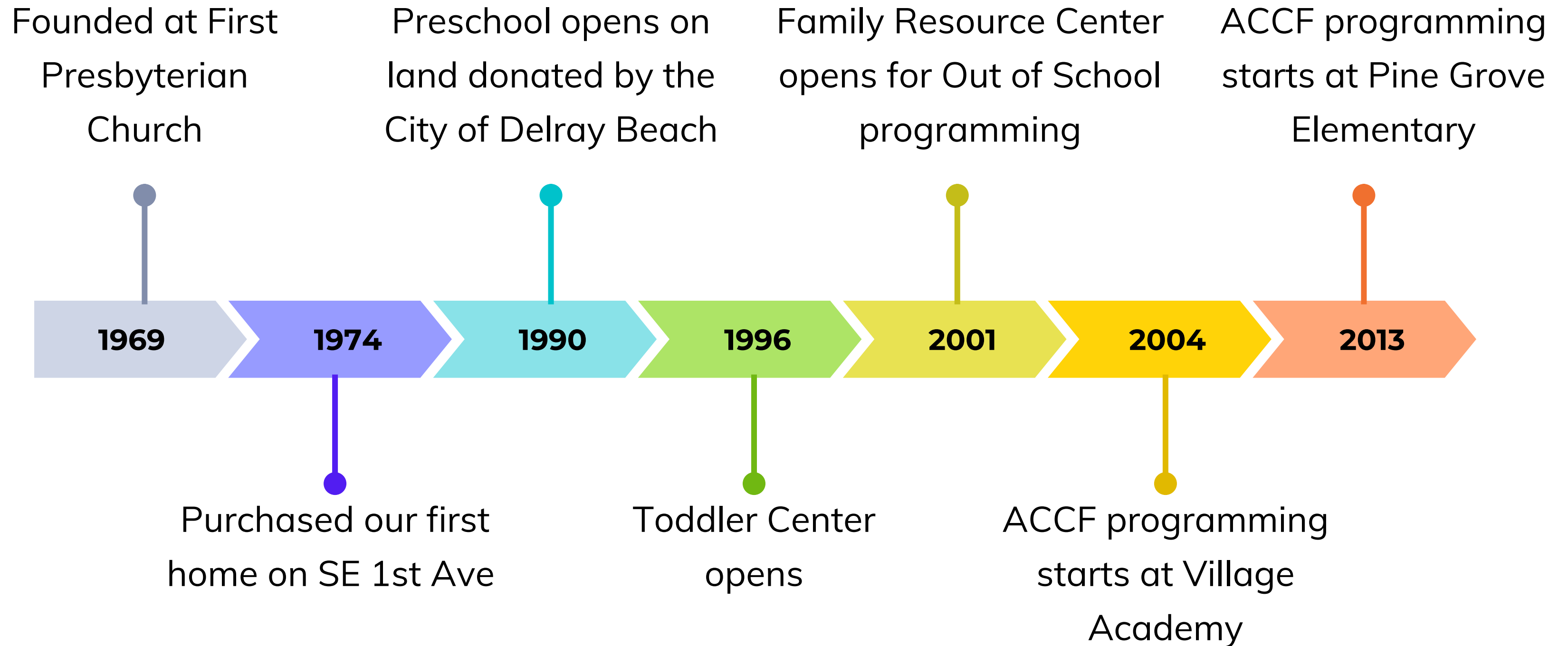

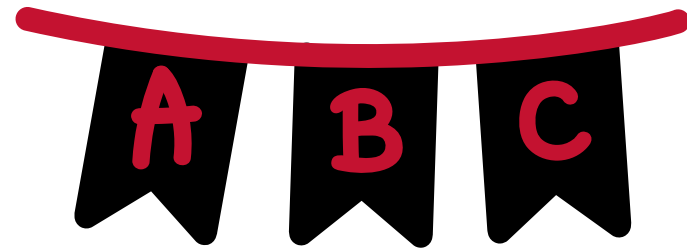

Early Learning Overview

- Serving children ages 1–5, with a capacity of 106 students
- Open Monday–Friday, 7:30 AM – 5:30 PM
- Focused on six key developmental domains:
 - Social-Emotional
 - Literacy
 - Physical
 - Cognitive Skills
 - Language
 - Math
- Led by CDA-Credentialed teachers
 - 5 teachers hold AA or BA degrees
- On-site Special Needs Resource Teacher through partnership with Palm Beach County School District

Developmental Screening

100% of eligible children (92) screened with Ages and Stages Questionnaire tools

38 children received interventions for identified concerns

Kindergarten Readiness

80% of children (28 of 35) scored "Ready for Kindergarten" on STAR Literacy Assessment

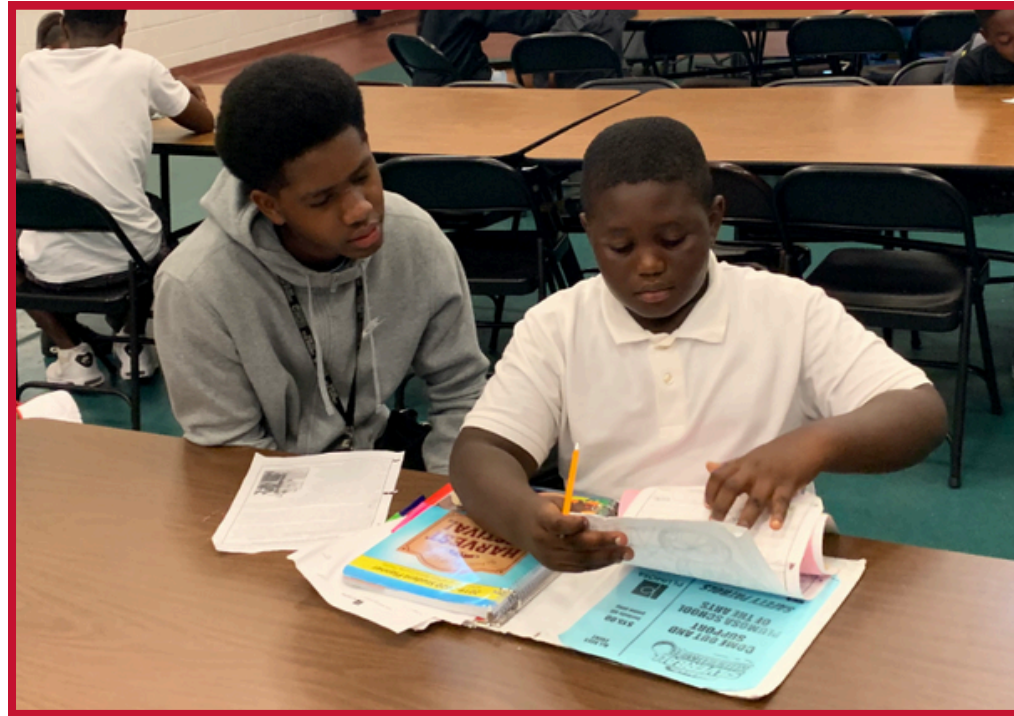
91% of typically-developing VPK students scored Average or Advanced

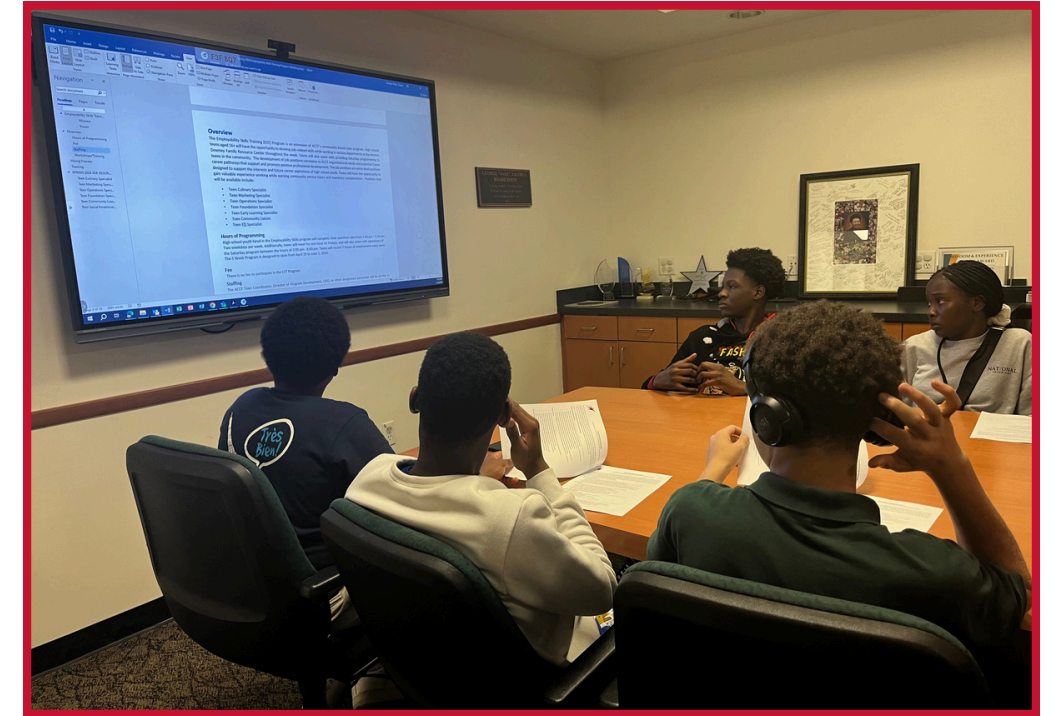

- Drowning Prevention Coalition, Community ID of the Palm Beaches, Suicide Prevention, & PB School District Choice Program

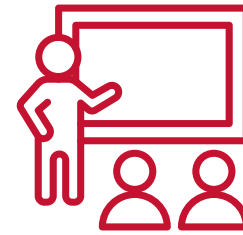

Home Tour

Our 22nd Annual Home Tour raised \$200,116, our most successful fundraising event of the year.



Witches Events

Our 13th Annual Witches Ride, 10th Annual Witches Brew, and Hat Making events raised a combined \$39,904.



Swing to Achieve

Our golf tournament at Par 3 raised \$34,695 to support our educational programs.

Total fundraising events in 2024–2025: 12 events generated \$295,329 in revenue, including over \$3,000 from boutique shopping partnerships.

Looking Ahead



EmpowerED: Closing the Gap



In Delray Beach, only **29% of students** read at grade level, and fewer than **30.4%** score a **3 or higher** on state standardized tests.

EmpowerED is a high-impact initiative supporting under-resourced K–12 students in Southern Palm Beach County through **personalized academic support, test preparation, mentorship, and social-emotional learning**—helping them overcome systemic barriers and reach their full potential.

Facility Improvements



Lighting Upgrades

Complete LED lighting conversion throughout all facilities, improving learning environments and energy efficiency



HVAC Replacement

Comprehensive HVAC system replacement to ensure comfortable, healthy environments for children and staff



Health & Safety

Internal audits and infrastructure improvements to meet Department of Health re-licensing requirements

These capital improvements ensure our facilities remain safe, efficient, and conducive to learning while reducing long-term operational costs.

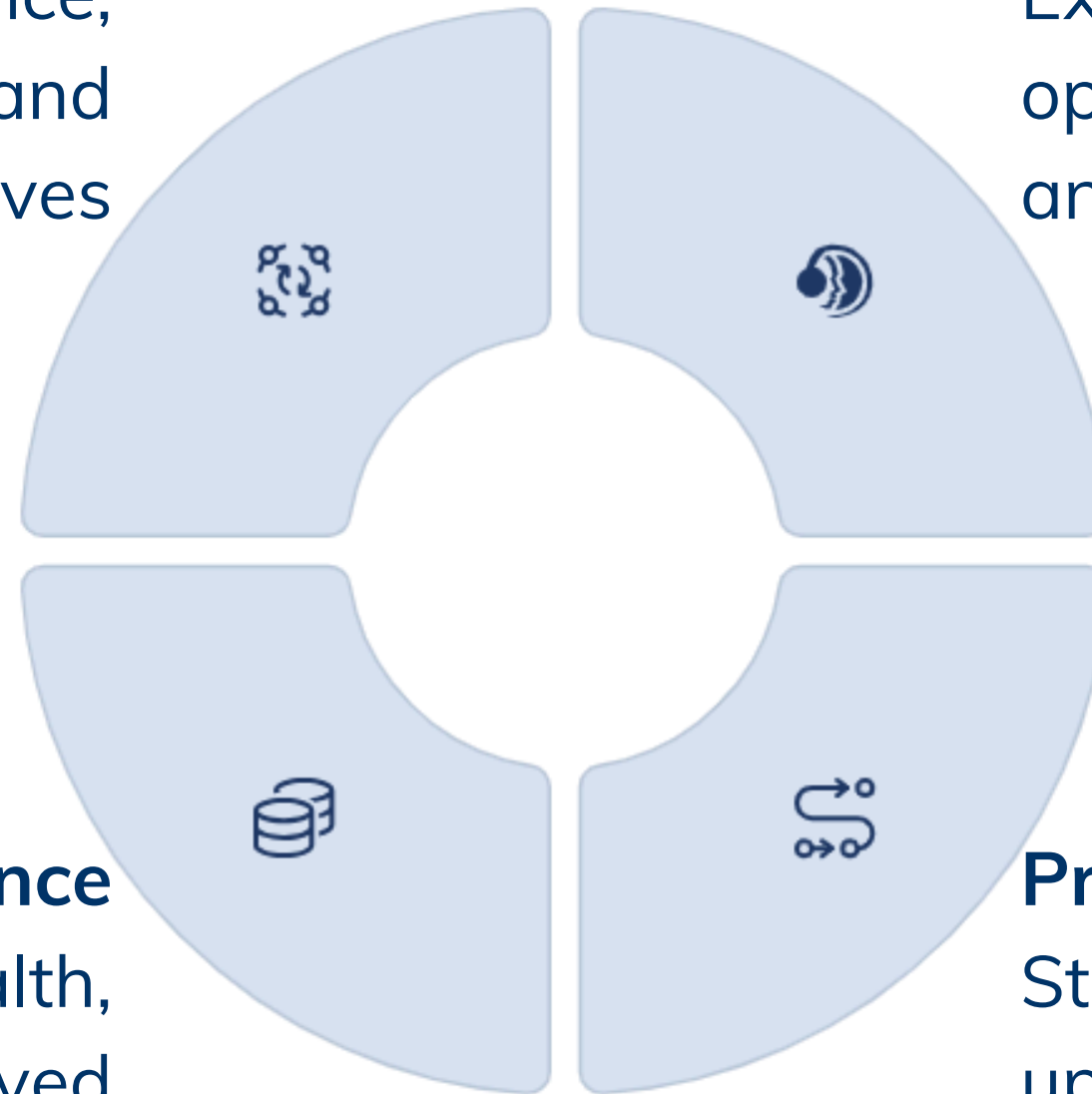
