In Compliance with Bid Form 2 of the Housing Rehabilitation Program Guidelines, the second low responsive, responsible bidder's cumulative total price, Dan Enterprises Team LLC is 17% higher than In-House cost estimate.



Form 12 BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES FOR THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY

- A. The general Contractor, or if none, the property owner, shall be responsible for assuring that each contractor or subcontractor evaluates each site before construction is initiated to determine if any site conditions may pose particular problems for the handling of any Regulated Substances.
