Traffic Performance Standards (TPS) Review

The Palm Beach County Traffic Division has reviewed the above referenced project Traffic Impact Statement, dated January 7, 2022, pursuant to the Traffic Performance Standards in Article 12 of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code (ULDC). The project is summarized as follows:

Municipality: Delray Beach

Location: East side of Military Trail, about 0.3 miles north of

Atlantic Avenue

PCN: 12-42-46-13-00-000-3020

Access: Full access driveway connection onto Military Trail

and cross access to the adjacent development to the

south

Existing Uses: General Retail = 23,827 SF

Proposed Uses: Replace 2,500 SF of existing retail space with adult

arcade use

New Daily Trips:

New Peak Hour Trips: 0 AM; 0 PM

Build-out: Not applicable

Based on our review, the Traffic Division has determined that the proposed project will not generate additional trips; therefore, the project **meets** the TPS of Palm Beach County.

Please note the receipt of a TPS approval letter does not constitute the review and issuance of a Palm Beach County Right-of-Way (R/W) Construction Permit nor does it eliminate any requirements that may be deemed as site related. For work within Palm Beach County R/W, a detailed review of the project will be provided upon submittal for a R/W permit application. The project is required to comply with all Palm Beach County standards and may include R/W dedication.

The County traffic concurrency approval is subject to the Project Aggregation Rules set forth in the Traffic Performance Standards Ordinance.

The approval letter shall be valid no longer than one year from date of issuance, unless an application for a Site Specific Development Order has been approved, an application for a Site Specific Development Order has been submitted, or the approval letter has been superseded by another approval letter for the same property.
