Masonry Modern Architectural features such as skyline relief by alternating parapet heights, cantilevering eyebrows providing covered home entries, cantilever balconies and stepping back to the third floor providing façade relief, embraces modern playfulness design. The façade design compliments the streetscape with light tropical stucco color, stone wall cladding adding wall texture with wood like ceiling accents.
