

RESOLUTION NO. 132-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH SELECTRON TECHNOLOGIES INC., FOR UTILITIES BILLING AND PERMIT INSPECTIONS AND BILLING; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND/OR RENEWALS THERETO AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming, and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City requires managed services for permit and utilities billing and inspections; and

WHEREAS, in 2004, a competitive solicitation was performed to obtain software and hardware for a new solution to provide the City's customers the ability to pay for utility bills and building permit fees using checks and credit cards via our interactive voice response and web-based portals; and

WHEREAS, Contractor was awarded the contract, and has been the City's sole utility billing and building permit fee payment solution for the City's customers since 2004; and

WHEREAS, Selectron is the only company authorized to sell, maintain, and service their own software and hardware, and has been deemed a City Standard as approved by the City's Finance Director; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with Selectron Technologies Inc. to obtain these products and services; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this Agreement between the City and Selectron Technologies Inc, which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A".

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and/or renewals thereto and take any other actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
