

RESOLUTION NO. 63-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH CINTAS CORPORATION NO. 2 FOR PURCHASE OF FIRST AID, EYE WASH, AND OTHER FIRE RESCUE-RELATED PRODUCTS AND SERVICES UTILIZING UNIVERSITY OF NEBRASKA BID NO. 3702-22-4618; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND/OR RENEWALS THERETO AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (the “City”) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide products and services in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City requires First Aid, Eye Wash, and other fire rescue-related products and services; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to obtain these products and services by utilizing an existing agreement with Cintas Corporation No. 2, for said products and services, which was awarded pursuant to University of Nebraska (the “University”) Request for Proposal No. 370222-4618, wherein the University was the lead agency for the National Intergovernmental Purchasing Alliance Company d/b/a OMNIA Partners, Public Sector Cooperative; and

WHEREAS, contracts solicited by the National Intergovernmental Purchasing Alliance Company d/b/a OMNIA Partners, Public Sector are accessible to state and local governmental entities, public and private primary, secondary and higher education entities, non-profit entities, and agencies for the public benefit; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this Agreement between the City and Contractor, which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit “A”.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and/or renewals and take any and all actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
