## **PROCLAMATION**

**WHEREAS**, First Presbyterian Church of Delray Beach was formally organized in 1925, during the early years of the City's development, and has maintained a continuous presence in the heart of the community for 100 years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Church's original Mission-style chapel, constructed in 1924 and still standing today, was listed on the Register of Historical Places in Delray Beach in 1999 and recognized as a State of Florida Historical Place of Interest in 2009, making it one of the City's most cherished landmarks and a lasting symbol of the faith, determination, and vision of Delray Beach's earliest residents; and

**WHEREAS**, during World War II, the Church provided worship services, hospitality, friendship, and comfort to the Airmen and Coast Guard personnel stationed in the area, serving as a spiritual home for those far from their own; and

**WHEREAS**, in response to a rapidly expanding congregation, a new Sanctuary was dedicated in 1977, enabling the Church to continue its growth and expand its ministries; and

**WHEREAS**, throughout its history, the Church has been instrumental in supporting and funding numerous local non-profit agencies, several of which began their work on the Church property, thereby nurturing organizations that continue to benefit Delray Beach and beyond; and

**WHEREAS**, for a century, the members and leaders of First Presbyterian Church have faithfully served the spiritual needs of Delray Beach through worship, education, fellowship, and outreach ministries, building generations of disciples; and

**WHEREAS**, the Church has been a beacon of compassion, generosity, and service, offering food, shelter, counseling, youth programs, music, and mission opportunities that have touched the lives of countless residents and families; and

**WHEREAS**, the guiding mission of First Presbyterian Church — "Building Disciples and Transforming Lives" — continues to inspire and strengthen not only its congregation but also the wider Delray Beach community; and

**WHEREAS**, the year 2025 marks the 100th Anniversary of this cornerstone institution of faith, service, and civic partnership in the City of Delray Beach.
