WHY OUR MODEL WORKS

- ✓ Early identification & prevent more costly academic and behavioral challenges later
- ✓ High instructional quality (CLASS) drives measurable gains in language, literacy, and social-emotional development
- ✓ School readiness outcomes demonstrate impact before children enter the K-12 system, reducing future remediation costs
- ✓ Integrated supports (education, screenings, family engagement) address the whole child, not just academics

COST COMPARISON & MODEL

Florida Average	\$12,000 – \$16,000 per child
Palm Beach County	\$19,000–\$22,000 per child
PBC Head Start Model (3 & 4)	\$17,000 – \$20,000 per child per year
ACCF’s Early Learning Program (1-5)	\$20,909 per child



ACCF’s investment delivers a comprehensive model—including early intervention, developmental screenings, family support, and measurable kindergarten readiness outcomes—not typically included in standard childcare.



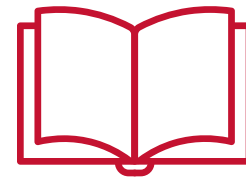

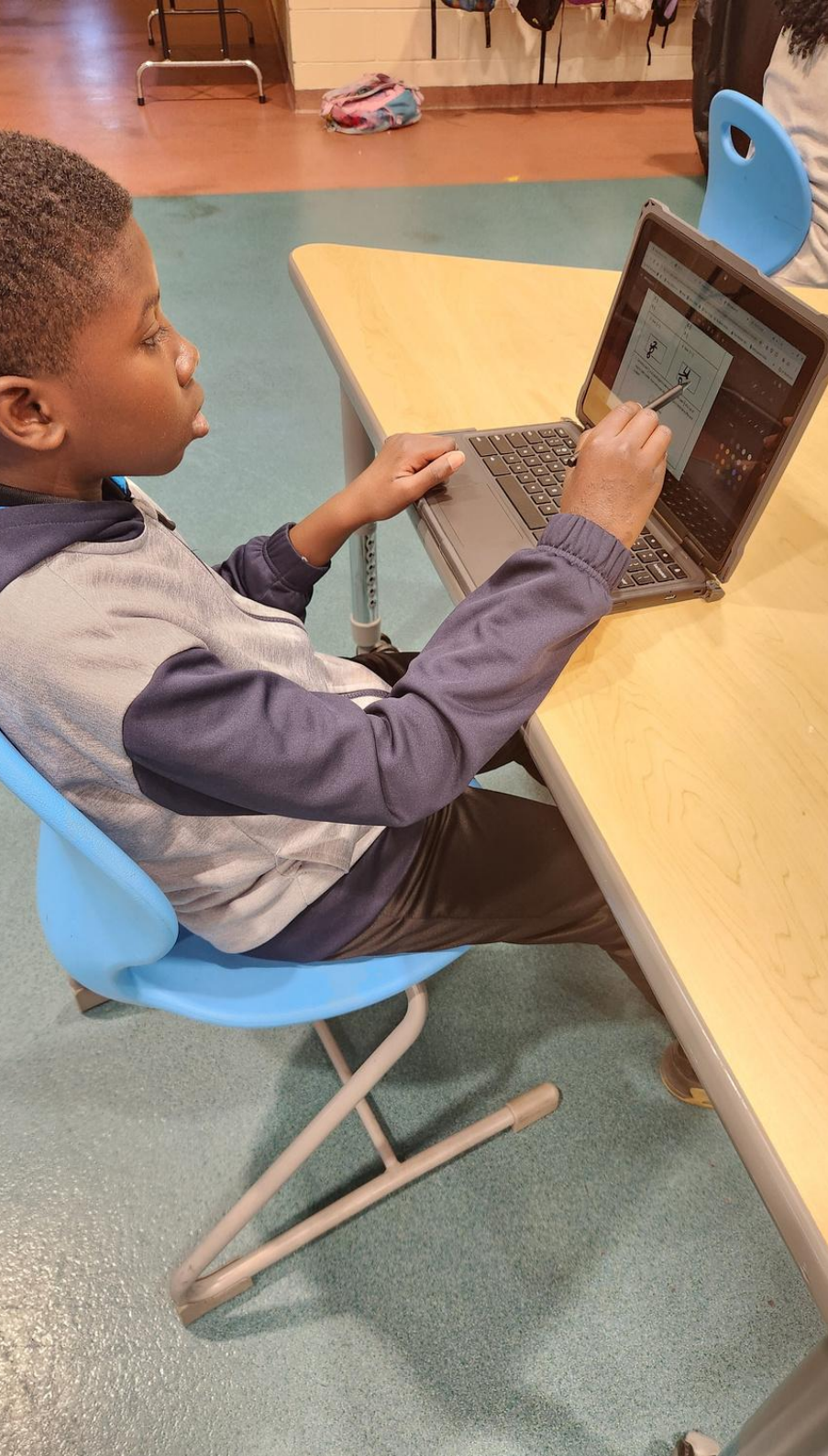

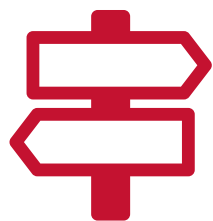
