RE: Delray Beach Community Redevelopment Agency (“CRA”)/Proposed Legislation
Related to Community Redevelopment Agencies for the 2018 Florida Legislature

This memorandum is an update for the CRA Board of Commissioners as to the status of the legislation related to Community Redevelopment Agencies that is currently pending in the State of Florida legislature during the 2018 legislative session. On January 12, 2017, the House of Representatives passed House Bill 17 by a vote of 72-32.

The companion bill, Senate Bill 432, was passed by the Senate’s Community Affairs Committee on November 7, 2017. Senate Bill is now currently referred to two committees in the Senate, the Appropriations Committee, and the Rules Committee. The bill was also referred to the Appropriations Subcommittee on Transportation, Tourism, and Economic Development. As of this date, none of the Senate Committees or Subcommittees have scheduled hearings related to Senate Bill 432.
