**WHEREAS,** implementing energy efficiency and other clean energy policies and programs can help boost economic opportunities and job creation while continuing to move the City of Delray Beach toward a sustainable future; and

WHEREAS, smarter energy use reduces the amount of electricity needed to power our lives, which helps avoid power plant emissions that can harm our health, pollute our air, and warm our climate; and
